

## MATH MINOR

### Declaring a Minor

Completed a minimum of 45 college credits.

Must be currently declared in a UW major.

Students will need to meet with their major advisor to declare a minor; no later than the third week of the quarter they plan to graduate.

---

### Math Minor Requirements (30-31 credits)

- Only courses coded or co-listed as “MATH” can be used to fulfill the minor requirements; no exceptions.
- At least 9 credits of MATH courses numbered 301 or higher taken in residence through the UW.
- All MATH courses must be completed with a numerical grade of 2.0 or higher.

#### Core Courses

- MATH 124 / 125 / 126 (15cr) – Calculus
- MATH 307 (3cr) – Differential Equations
- MATH 308 (3cr) – Matrix Algebra
- MATH 309 (3cr) – Linear Analysis

OR

- MATH 134 / 135 / 136 (15cr) – Accel Honors Calculus
- AP Calculus (10cr); posted to UW transcript

#### Electives

- 6 credits of MATH courses numbered 301 or higher.
