### Declaring a Minor

Completed a minimum of 45 college credits.

Must be currently declared in a UW major.

Students will need to meet with their major advisor to declare a minor no later than the third week of the quarter they plan to graduate.

### Math Minor Requirements (30 credits)

- Only courses coded or co-listed as “MATH” can be used to fulfill the minor requirements; no exceptions.
- At least 9 credits of MATH courses numbered 301 or higher taken in residence through UW - Seattle.
- All MATH courses must be completed with a numerical grade of 2.0 or higher.

#### Core Courses

- MATH 124 or 134 (5 cr) – Calculus I
- MATH 125 or 135 (5 cr) – Calculus II
- MATH 126 or 136 (5 cr) – Calculus III
- MATH 300 or 334 (3 cr/5 cr) – Mathematical Reasoning or Honors Adv. Calculus

#### Electives

- 10-12 credits of MATH courses numbered 301 or higher; excluded courses: MATH 307, MATH 308, MATH 309, MATH 324.
